POSITION SUMMARY:

This Distribution Supervisor is a key leader who is responsible for ensuring that distribution commitments are met safely, on time, on budget, and with the highest level of quality possible.

The Distribution Supervisor provides hands-on line supervision and direction to a culturally diverse team of Assemblers, Leads, and support personnel in order to meet production goals. Gathers data, observes shipping processes, and uses metrics and process monitors to predict and plan continuous improvement opportunities. Responsible for identifying, collaborating and implementing enhancements to shipping efficiencies, resource planning and training needs, line layouts, equipment optimization, and quality initiatives.

PRIMARY ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

General duties

- Ensure all needed documents are printed ie: work order pick lists, shipping fulfillment slips, travelers, line layouts and line check sheets.
- Calculate and monitor inventory levels and notifies Dept Manager when discrepancies occur or will affect daily production.
- Maintain an organized shipping and warehouse based on company policies and procedures.
- Direct daily activities of shipping team and assign tasks as needed.
- Responsible for training employees within shipping department.
- Responsible for helping and covering the receiving department and drexel lift truck duties as they relate to stocking, pulling and rotating finished and raw product as needed.
- Perform various other duties as specified by the Department Manager.
- Ensure accurate and timely shipment of all sales orders.
- Ensure the customer requests per sales order are accurately followed, working closely with Customer Service.
- Work with Manager to ensure best methods and overall freight costs are implemented.
- Work closely with Manager to ensure outbound shipments are in alignment with specific regulations, guidelines and requirements.
